I. Outlining the Resurrection Stories Focused on Jesus:

The Apostle Paul, in the crescendo of his first letter to the Corinthians, provides additional witness and a theological interpretation of the importance of subscribing belief to the physical resurrection of Jesus from the dead. (1 Corinthians 15:1-58 has been divided, below, into three pericopae for teaching purposes.)

B. Each resurrection vignette (or narrative pericope) is purposed to make a S_____ confession . . . a Creedlet.

(Or "point") which I term a "creedlet," a mini-confessional statement (or proposition). When taken as a whole, the sixteen creedlets orb out our understanding of the resurrection of Jesus. (The proposed creedlets are suggestions. After your own study, you may find yourself able to more accurately wordsmith them.)
