

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Welcome to the 2023-2024 Yearbook for Maritime Christian College. It is my pleasure to speak to some of the highlights you will find in this year's edition.

We had three new graduands from our Disciple Maker Certificate Program. This is our second group of graduands since MCC launched its online certificate programs in September 2020. Congratulations are in order for Bonita Burnham of Waterloo, QC, Carlos Medrano of Halifax, NS, and Larry MacLaren of Fort Erie, ON who received their Disciple Maker Certificate Level 1.

In 2023 Maritime Christian College launched the Master of Arts in Disciple Making & Ministry Leadership Program. The diverse

geographic locations for the students in the program is evidence of one of the biggest benefits from online learning: students can study the material online from wherever their home is, and can still be connected in digital discussion groups that enhance the learning experience for them. This format also allows MCC to work with course developers and course professors who have academic credentials in the area of study, and who also have deep experience in applying what they know into their everyday life as a follower of Jesus. MCC has been blessed to work with the course developers and professors highlighted in this 2023-2024 Yearbook.

In 2020 Maritime Christian College took a bold step towards a focus on aligning our academic programs around the theology and practical application of disciple making. As we have continued to develop and offer programs with disciple making as the core element, I am encouraged by the way students are applying what they are learning. You can see some of the comments of the recent graduands in this yearbook.

One of the passages of Scripture that has impacted me in the past decade are Jesus' words in Matthew 7:24-27. 
ANNUAL Enrollment and Financial Reports

Academic Program Highlights from 2023-2024


- 45 students enrolled in online classes: 35 in undergrad programs and 10 in the master's program. Geographic location: Canada-37 (AB-1, MB-1, NB-10, NS-6 ON-11, PE-7, QC-1), Ethiopia-1, Nigeria-2, and USA-5 (KY-1, OK-1, TX-3)
- Continual evaluation of courses and programs to raise the bar on the quality of course development and instruction
- Logos Inclusive Access trial a Bible study program for ministers or students to prepare lessons or write sermons online efficiently
- Developing a new introductory certificate called "The Disciple Maker's Path" to be launched September 2024
- Exploring resourcing church leaders in Ontario
- Updating policies and procedures to reflect the new online environment

MCC Enrollment


Headcount - full-time, part-time, and auditing students




Full-time Equivalency (FTE) – full-time students plus full-time equivalent of part-time student credit hours; no audit students

Fiscal Highlights from 2023

- The 503 University Avenue property was sold for a net of \$2.1 million which was transferred to MCC's investment accounts to replenish them from the significant drawdown that has been going on for several years (not shown in Operating Revenue).
- The MCC office relocated to rented space inside Sherwood Christian Church in Charlottetown for \$1,000/month. Staff work from the office one day/ week and from home the rest of the week.
- 2023 Operating Revenue and Expenses include dorm room income and expenses for January-April, until the sale of the property, not a full year
- Tuition income increased by 123% with a full year of the new Masters Program.
- Donations from individuals decreased by -32% which caused a higher draw on investments
- Course developers and professors increased by 82% due to an increased number of online courses

Tom Marshall asked Katie about her experience and new role:

What brought you to MCC in 2011?

When I was in art school . . . I was coming up against universal concepts I wasn't equipped for. People would say, 'Ask the universe and you'll get your work done.' [or] an instructor said, 'Jesus and Buddha can control people with extra strong mind vibrations.' That was the first time I had ever heard anything like that . . . I realized being in that world, I had inherited my parent's faith, and I needed to figure it out if I believed it for myself . . . That's when I shocked everyone in my life and said I'll go to Bible college for a year.

You came for one year but stayed for four?

I just came for the one year Biblical Studies Certificate - But Eileen Tanner was one of my professors and she invested a lot into myself and the other girls. She encouraged me to continue on and said "You're already one year into a bachelor's degree, you might as well continue." So, with encouragement and a lot of help studying, I stayed all four years and got my bachelors.

What is one take away from your MCC experience?

Honestly, learning how to study the Bible and history. Realizing anyone can do it. In our life now we draw on what we learned at MCC with the studying tools we gained – we share them with people. Like when we have a bible study we pull out all our research books and we show them how to use them, how to find information and answers to their Bible questions.

What about in your roll as Director of Marketing, what would you like people to know?

I want people to realize they can take college level Bible classes from anywhere. It doesn't have to be expensive, it doesn't have to be scary, it can fit into your life wherever you're working, if you have kids, whether you're involved in church leadership or not, if you are looking for a more solid foundation. You don't have to sacrifice the way your life is to go to bible college. You can do it alongside your life. It naturally weaves in with what you are doing.
